## Need help paying for childcare?

United Way of Southern Nevada is currently offering financial assistance for families impacted by COVID-19.

### Who Qualifies?

- Residents of Clark County with children ages 0-12\*
- Experienced a financial hardship related to COVID-19
- Have a need for care, including work and school for parents/guardians

### What Assistance is Available?

- Eligible families receive up to \$100 per week, per child, in tuition assistance
- Eligible childcare providers may receive additional assistance to cover the cost of caring for eligible children

### How Do I Apply?

- Families may apply for assistance through their childcare provider
- Childcare providers may apply to be an approved provider through UWSN
